## 2. SUBJECTED GOODS

<b>Regulated products:</b>	All goods accompanied with a <b>Letter Of Credit</b>
<b>Second-hand goods:</b>	Not allowed
<b>Prohibited goods:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Substances that deplete the ozone layer</li><li>- Firecrackers and other pyrotechnics</li><li>- Toys imitating fire weapons</li><li>- The export of ferrous and nonferrous metal waste, metals and raw hides and skins, including in the framework of outward processing.</li><li>- Food products whose prices are subsidized by the state(1) : durum wheat, common wheat, barley, semolina, flour, pasta, couscous, bags packaged pasteurized milk. Palm seedlings</li><li>- Sheep and cattle breeding</li><li>- Objects representing a national interest in terms of history, art or archeology, including old vehicles</li></ul>
<b>Counterfeited goods:</b>	Not allowed

**3. VERIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

<b>Testing:</b>	Test reports must be from laboratories accredited in ISO 17025 by an ILAC member Type certificates such as TSE can be accepted in some cases.
<b>Standards:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Algerian standards</li> <li>- International standards</li> <li>- National Standards</li> </ul>
<b>Labeling:</b>	<p>Labels, markings and instructions shall be legible, well stuck, and not easy to remove, unless otherwise specified in the applicable standard or national deviations.</p> <p>Generally; the label should minimally contain the below points <b>in Arabic</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Manufacturer's name or Trademark</li> <li>- Product description</li> <li>- Net quantity in metric units</li> <li>- User manual, if applicable</li> <li>- Country of origin</li> </ul>
<b>Documents:</b>	<p>To be submitted before inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- RFC</li> <li>- Proforma</li> <li>- Letter of Credit</li> <li>- Valid test report (if testing is requested by LC)</li> </ul> <p>To be submitted after inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Final Invoice</li> <li>- Bill of Lading</li> </ul>
