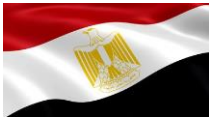

Registration at GOEIC:	Factories, Manufacturers or Trademark Owners of regulated products must register with Egypt's General Organization of Export and Import Control (GOEIC) by 15th March 2016 to continue to export to Egypt. Exporters can process registrations themselves or alternatively, TÜV AUSTRIA can assist exporter with the registration. All documents to be submitted to TÜV AUSTRIA to review and assist with submission to GOEIC, together with the Authorization form. The GOEIC forms to be completed are available upon request.
