## 2. SUBJECTED GOODS

**Prohibited / Banned Goods:**

As per Ministerial Decree no. 20 of 2017, Depending on the President of the Republic decision and to rationalize the imports according to the economic reform program and as part of the country's effort to tackle the trade balance deficit, decision was made to ban some import commodities to Sudan.

Some products have been [excluded from the list of Ban/Prohibition](#) based on Ministry Trade Letter no. WT/MK15 dated 28/01/2018 and Ministry of Trade Letter no. 64/9/1 dated 28/06/2018

### 3. VERIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

<b>Testing:</b>	Test reports must be from an ISO 17025 accredited laboratory according to the applicable standard. Type certificates such as TSE can be accepted in some cases.																												
<b>Standards:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Sudanese Standards; SDS</li> <li>- Other standards in case of no SDS available (must be previously confirmed by SSMO)</li> </ul>																												
<b>Labeling:</b>	<p>Labeling and marking of the shipped product is necessary to be checked with the labeling and marking requirements of the related standard followed.</p> <p>The below points are strongly encouraged to be available on the shipped product data or label:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Manufacturer`s name or Trademark</li> <li>- Importer name</li> <li>- Country of origin</li> <li>- Product Name</li> </ul> <p>The labelling and marking on the product and on the packaging are accepted if it is in only English or both in English &amp; Arabic or in Arabic only.</p> <p>Remaining markings (manufacturer name, size, dates, country of origin etc.) shall be in Arabic or in English.
